ESTIMATED POINTS FOR THE PRINCIPLE APPLICANT (“PA”)	72

REMARKS

- The final assessment score is thus calculated to be 72 points.
- The minimum score to pass in the Federal Skilled Worker Program is 67 points.
- *All points are preliminary estimates based without official language results and review of employer verification letters, an evaluation of your international education credentials, and other relevant supporting documentation to back your claimed points.*
